#### Federal Law 23 CFR 490, Subpart B

- Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP)
- Applies to all public roads
- Explains how to calculate each target
- State DOTs and MPOs shall establish targets for each Performance Measure
- Sets deadlines for target setting and implementation

## 5 Required Safety Performance Targets

- # of Traffic Fatalities
- Rate of Traffic Fatalities
- # of Serious Injuries
- Rate of Serious Injuries
- # of Non-Motorized
   Fatalities and Serious
   Injuries

- This request is for MN areas of the MIC area only
- MIC must adopt safety PM targets for MN portion of the MIC area by February 2020.
- MIC adopted safety PM targets for WI portion of the MIC area in October 2019.

## MIC options

#### The MIC can either:

 Adopt safety PM targets adopted by the state (MnDOT)

- or -

 Develop and adopt their own safety PM targets

## MIC has chosen to adopt MnDOT targets

 Most MN MPOs are adopting MnDOT targets

## Reporting and Progress

The MIC must meet or "make significant progress towards meeting" targets on 4 of the 5 PMs

- TIP
- Long Range Transportation
   Plan

Rate of Traffic Fatalities	0.622 per 100 million VMT	0.626 per 100 million VMT
Number of Serious Injuries	1711	1714.2
Rate of Serious Injuries	2.854 per 100 Million VMT	2.854 per100 Million VMT
Number of Non-Motorized Fatalities & Serious Injuries	267.5	317.0

VMT = Vehicle Miles Traveled
