Public Comments Generated

- WisDOT released 2021 Safety Performance Measure Targets on August 31, 2020 for inclusion into upcoming TIP documents.
 - MIC staff added the 2021 Safety Performance Measure Targets to the final adopted 2021-2024 TIP.
- WisDOT identified the Transit Asset Management (TAM) targets were referencing 2018.
 - Consultation with the local transit agency was executed and 2021 TAM targets are included in the 2021-2024 TIP.
- FTA requested the 2021-2024 TIP include current or previous year performance metric data for the TAM targets.
 - In consultation with the local transit agency, previous year performance metric data was included in the TIP.
- A citizen provided an email expressing concern that a replacement or reconstruction/reopening of County Trunk Highway W over the Nemadji River Bridge is not addressed in the TIP. The bridge was damaged during recent flooding in the county.
 - No changes were made to the TIP document.
