Amendment #7 – 2022-2025 Duluth Area TIP

Proposed for Approval 6/15/2022

Additional funding and expanded scope of work in FY 2023 for St. Louis Co project ID 069-609-050 and 069-609-050AC

St Louis County has requested the addition of funding in the amount of \$1,000,000 and an expanded scope to include storm sewer improvements and additional sidewalk work on Woodland Ave. Based on the criteria adopted in the MIC Public Involvement Plan, these changes require a formal TIP Amendment to the current 2022-2025 Duluth area TIP.

Amendment 7 adds additional funding and expanded project scope, as follows:

- 069-609-050 will add \$1,000,000 to the project total
- 069-609-050 will include scope language for sidewalk improvements, and storm sewer
- 069-609-050AC will include scope language for sidewalk improvements, and storm sewer
