


What is the Metropolitan Transportation Plan?

- A long-range, fiscally-constrained plan to guide the development of a transportation system that is safe, well-maintained, well-integrated and serves all users.
- Incorporates a community-driven vision for our future transportation network.
- Provides a framework of goals and objectives to guide multi modal transportation investments.




What is the Metropolitan Transportation Plan?

- All MPOs are required to develop a longrange Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)
- Minimum 20-year planning horizon
- Updated every 5 years



What is the Metropolitan Transportation Plan?

- All MPOs are required to develop a longrange Metropolitan Transportation Plan (MTP)
- Minimum 20-year planning horizon
- Update every 5 years
- The MIC's 2050 MTP Update must be approved by the Policy Board by October 19, 2024.



 Establishes a vision and goals for the Duluth-Superior transportation system




Long Range Transportation Plan


- Addresses all modes of travel
- Projected 25-year revenues
- Updated every 5 years

Identifies both capital investments & needed studies to support that vision

Transportation Improvement Programs (TIPs)

- 4 –year federally-funded infrastructure projects
- Consistent with MTP investment priorities






Annual Work Program

- Short-term, planning projects
- Reflects MTP priorities

18-month Planning Scope

- Inventory current transportation infrastructure
- Update area demographics, analyze travel patterns
- Conduct comprehensive stakeholder engagement
- Describe local transportation values, issues, opportunities
- Incorporate system performance measures, future trends & technologies
- Identify potential transportation improvement projects
- Demonstrate fiscal constraint
