Highway Safety Targets PM1

- U.S. Department of Transportation Requires States/MPOs to establish performance measures for the Highway Safety Improvement Program (HSIP).
- MPOs establish HSIP targets by either agreeing to plan and program projects so that they contribute to the accomplishment of State targets or commit to a quantifiable HSIP target for the MPO area.
- MPOs must annually establish CY HSIP performance targets.
- WisDOT released CY 2024 Safety targets August 31, 2023.
