Study: Roundabouts could reduce crashes in Duluth


Roundabouts — circular road intersections where motorists all drive in one direction to their separate exits — are becoming increasingly common.

There may be a traffic roundabout in Duluth's future.

Roundabouts — circular road intersections where motorists all drive in one direction to their separate exits — are becoming increasingly common across Wisconsin, with one near Ashland and another planned for Superior.

No immediate plans exist to convert any existing Minnesota intersections in or near Duluth to roundabouts. But a Duluth-Superior Metropolitan Interstate Council-sponsored study of eight intersections found roundabouts might work well at

"We set the groundwork for work the city might do" sometime in the future, Chicka said.





- Intersection Control Evaluations were completed in 2021/2022.
- City of Rice Lake was included in the PMT.
- Rice Lake Rd (CSAH 4) at...
 - Ridgeview Rd (CR 694) → Left/Right Turn Lanes
 - West Calvary Rd (CR 234) → Single Lane Roundabout
 - Martin Rd (CSAH 9) → Single Lane Roundabout
 - West Tischer Rd (CSAH 2) → Do Nothing



Project Management

- Utilized a Project Management Team (PMT) approach.
- Operated two PMTs simultaneously...
 - Agency PMT
 - Included representation from...
 - Rice Lake
 - Duluth
 - Canosia Township
 - St. Louis County departments (Planning, Land and Public Works)
 - Internal PMT
 - Employees within Public Works and Planning
 - Consultant (Bolton & Menk)
- St. Louis County has been working with both PMTs since April 2023.

Rice Lake Road Corridor Goals

- Improve traffic operations and safety at the intersections
- Preserve the function of Rice Lake Road
- Create a corridor that invites development
- Manage access and facilitate a new city street network
- Support traffic calming
- Incorporate accessibility for pedestrians and bicyclists

Project Funding

- Total construction cost estimate = \$40.1 million.
- Currently working through assembling project funding.
- Will submit a funding application to the Transportation Alternatives Program for \$600,000 for the trail along Rice Lake Rd.
- Will submit a funding application to the RAISE Grant Program for \$25 million.
- Other funding sources will likely include state and federal program and discretionary funds and potentially legislative earmark(s).
