From there, click on the hyperlink that reads, “[Subscribe to BNM e-mail updates & RSS Feeds](#)”

Then to subscribe to LNM feeds you would select **9th District Local Notice to Mariners** to get the LNM for the Great Lakes. To subscribe to BNM feeds, scroll down to “**Subscribe to 9th Coast Guard District Broadcast Notice to Mariners:**” and select Sector Northern Great Lakes. After each selection, the site will prompt you to enter your email. After confirming your email, you will then be subscribed and sent subscriptions to your inbox.

LNM’s tell you updates on bridge maintenance, ATON, and other activities occurring in navigable waterways. BNM’s are usually advertising hazards in waterways.
